Materials

- Yarn: DK weight yarn in two colors, approximately 500g of main color and 100g of contrast color
- Needles: US size 8 (5mm) circular needles, 24" or 32" in length
- Tapestry needle

Gauge

- 18 stitches and 24 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch

Finished Size

- Blanket: 29" x 74cm
- Hat: 3mths (14" circumference), 6mths (16" circumference)

Instructions

Blanket

1. Cast on 120 stitches with main color yarn.
2. Knit 2 rows.
3. Row 3: *K2, P2; repeat from * to end of row.
4. Rows 4-6: Knit.
5. Row 7: *K2, P2; repeat from * to end of row.
6. Rows 8-10: Knit.

7. Repeat rows 3-10 until piece measures 29" from cast on edge.
8. Bind off all stitches.

Hat

3mths

1. Cast on 80 stitches with main color yarn.
2. Join to work in the round, being careful not to twist stitches.
3. Knit 1 round.
4. Row 2: *K2, P2; repeat from * to end of round.
5. Rows 3-5: Knit.
6. Row 6: *K2, P2; repeat from * to end of round.
7. Rows 7-9: Knit.
8. Repeat rows 2-9 until piece measures 5" from cast on edge.
9. Next round: *K2tog, P2; repeat from * to end of round.
10. Next round: Knit.
11. Repeat last 2 rounds until 40 stitches remain.
12. Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through remaining stitches and pull tight to close hat.

6mths

1. Cast on 96 stitches with main color yarn.
2. Join to work in the round, being careful not to twist stitches.

3. Knit 1 round.
4. Row 2: *K2, P2; repeat from * to end of round.
5. Rows 3-5: Knit.
6. Row 6: *K2, P2; repeat from * to end of round.
7. Rows 7-9: Knit.
8. Repeat rows 2-9 until piece measures 6" from cast on edge.
9. Next round: *K2tog, P2; repeat from * to end of round.
10. Next round: Knit.
11. Repeat last 2 rounds until 48 stitches remain.
12. Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through remaining stitches and pull tight to close hat.

Additional Notes

- You can use any DK weight yarn for this pattern. I used Lion Brand Vanna's Choice yarn in the colors "White" and "Bluebell."

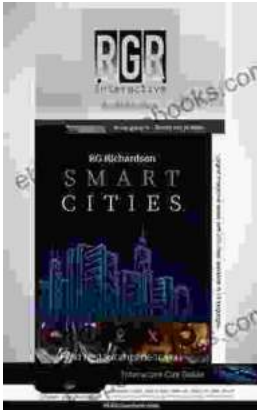

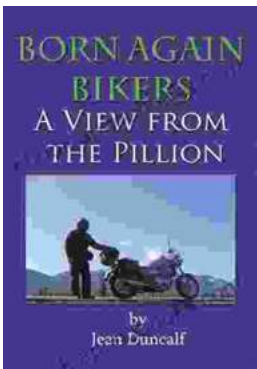
